Information

Rise Quality! is a seminar for youth work professionals and/or project coordinators of youth work organizations, who train volunteer youth group leaders and/or accompany international youth exchanges. It aims

- to bring forward a high quality standard in international youth work by developing a common training program for international youth group leaders to make sure international leader teams are on the same level;
- acknowledge the young volunteer's engagement and time spent and make the engagement in youth group facilitation more attractive;
- develop a draft framework on a possible international youth leader training/preparation material for cooperation in international youth work/a tool box of methods. The precise result isn't fixed yet and depends on the aims and ideas of the participants.

For who

Youth Workers and/or project coordinators with experience in international youth work and a motivation to develop quality in international youth work further. It would be good, if participants had an overview over the youth work structures in their country, on funding issues, professional standards, methods and networks.

The aim is a mixed-age group of professionals who have an idea about which training content and methods are necessary/obligatory for volunteer youth group leaders. For the online-sessions (four meetings, four hours each), there is no linit of the number of participants. For the physical meeting (five days) there is a total number of 16 participants – four of each participating organization. The training is open to participants who are residents of France, Germany, Lithuania or Slovakia.

Participants will be asked to fill in a small questionnaire preceding each online-session for preparation. The questionnaires aim to collect input, experiences, information on law and regulations from the certain countries and are fundament for the discussions we will have online. So participants should be ready to contribute to the questionnaire and the seminars actively.
